I extend my warm welcome to all the Plus one students and wish you all a pleasant time at Trinity Lyceum.

Passing out the 10th class is a milestone in your life and all of you have come out with flying colours. I extend my warm congrats to you. I extend my sincere appreciation for your dear teachers who brought out the best in you and your parents who accompanied you in your life's journey.

But Plus two is critical to you. You have chosen your stream of studies: Science, or Commerce with your specialisations, which will determine your future studies and moreover your career, profession and future life. So these two years are critical, for it decides what you are and who you will be. So stay tuned. Stay alert.

An overview of the 2020 results: Lyceum has secured 100% results in ISC and ICSE. Out of 259 students who appeared for ICSE, 220 secured distinction, the highest score being 98.80% for Arya Satheesh.

99 students took the ISC exam and 86 got distinction the highest for science being 97.25% scored by Ananthakrishnan.

In commerce an all time high of 99 % was scored by AS Gaurikrishna, may be the state topper. Out of 358 students who appeared for ICE & ICSE 306 secured distinction. 24 students scored 100% for various subjects. I wish to congratulate all the students for their marvellous academic achievements and pray that they reach greater heights of glory. *'Keep your eyes on the stars and your feet on the ground'*.

Regarding the academic scheme: For ISC we offer two streams. Science and Commerce. English is a compulsory subject and each subject comprises of two components: Theory and Project/practical.

For English, Maths, Economics, Commerce, Accounts and Business studies, Theory is for 80 marks and 20 for project. For Physics, Chemistry and Biology, Theory for 70 marks, Practical and Project for 30 marks. Second language offered are Malayalam or Hindi for which there is only theory for 100 marks.

Promotion criteria: at least 35% for a minimum of four subjects: English and any other three subjects. Minimum attendance is 75% of total working days. For class XI th the question paper for the annual exam is set by the council. So get set and go for learning from day one onwards.

To conclude, you know well about the challenges and constraints the Covid-19 pandemic has put on our education sector.

We are compelled to keep our schools closed. Students and teachers keep at home. But don't get disappointed.

In 1920 it was the Spanish flu, in 1820 it was the Cholera, in 1720 it was Bubonic plague. Every century had its own pandemic. Once in 100 years the world is devastated by a deadly pandemic.
