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



Lycean 2023 our school annual is a collection of student articles, sketches, poems. As you flip through the pages you can see the hues and festivities that took place in our school.



- Fountain pens with gold nibs, have the ability to learn. Due to the soft metal used it can slowly adjust and adapt to your writing style over time.









DROUPADI MURMU


Droupadi Murmu is an Indian politician who is serving as the 15th and current President of India since 25th July, 2022. She was born on 20 June, 1958. She is a member of Bharatiya Janata Party. She is the first person belonging to the tribal community and also the second woman after Pratibha Patil to hold the office. She is also the youngest person to occupy the post of President. She also served as the 9th Governor of Jharkhand between 2015 and 2021, and held various portfolios in the cabinet of Government of Odisha between 2000 and 2004.

Droupadi Murmu was born to a Santali family in Uparbeda Village in the Baidapasi area of Rairangput, Odisha. Her father's name is Biranchi Narayan Tudu. Her family named her Puti Tudu. She was renamed by her school teacher to Dhroupadi and her name was changed several times to those in-

cluding Durpadi and Dirpadi in the past. Murmu studied elementary education at the local primary school in Uparbeda. At age 5, she moved to Bhubaneswar for higher studies. She completed secondary education from Girl's High School Unit -2, and graduated in B.A from Rama Devi Women's College.

She married Shyam Charan Murmu, a banker, in 1980 at age 22. She had two sons and a daughter.

In 1997, Droupadi Murmu was elected as the councilor of the Rairangpur Nagar Panchayat as an independent candidate from a reserved seat for women. She then joined the Bharatiya Janata Party. She won the 2000 Odisha Legislative Assembly election from Rairangpur Assembly constituency and served two terms in the Odisha Legislative Assembly between 2000 and 2009. During the BJP and BJD coaition government in Odisha, she was the Minister of State with independent charge for Commerce and Transportation from 6th March 2000 to 6th Augusht 2002, and Fisheries and Animal Resources Development from 6th August, 2002 to 16th May 2004.








Empowerment on Women




NIKOLA TESLA – THE FORGOTTEN GENIUS

"If you want to find the secrets of the universe, think in terms of energy, frequency and vibration". Nikola Tesla

Tesla was born in the town of Smiljan in present - day. Croatia on July 10, 1856 to Milutin, an Eastern Orthodox minister, and Georgina, a brilliant woman who was an inventor herself. Tesla 's birth seemed to foreshadow his life's work, as his mother was in labor during a massive lightning storm. According to family legend, the midwife said halfway through the birth: this child will be a child of darkness to which his mother replied, "No, he will be a



child of light ." his mother was not wrong —as we know today Tesla is the reason we have alternating current.



Tesla moved around Europe and eventually ended up in Budapest. He had found a job as an electrical engineer with the Central Telephone Company in Budapest. While walking around a park in the city one day, Tesla got one of his visions. He knew how to build an induction motor. He picked up a stick, found a patch of dirt and sketched out his idea there and then. He built a pro-



totype of the motor. He knew the importance of it but couldn't drum up much interest for his invention in Europe

In 1882, Tesla settled in Paris to work for the French branch of Thomas Edison's electric company. he started off installing indoor lighting but the managers noticed his talents and had him doing more complicated work. Designing and building dynamos and motors, he was soon travelling throughout Europe fixing problems at other Edison branches. Two years later, Tesla's manager offered him a job at Edison Machine works in New York City. Tesla initially had a good impression of Edison. Edison was also impressed by Tesla, later saying" I have had many hard- working assistants but you take the cake." This mutual admiration didn't last. They would become bitter rivals. Edison and Tesla disagreed over the alternating current and the direct current, with Tesla favouring alternating and Edison favouring direct, but its still unclear if that disagreement was the primary reason Tesla ended up leaving the company. Tesla and Edison also differed in their approaches to business and science. Edison was attuned to the marketing side of things, while Tesla was highly focused on the scientific invention and innovation part of the work. Edison's company offered him 50000 dollars as a bonus, if he could improve some machine that ran on DC. When he did, the manager refused to pay up. The manager and Edison claimed the challenge had been issued jokingly. Another account of the story has Edison telling Tesla:" Tesla, you don't understand our American humor". Regardless of the reason, the fact is that Tesla departed from Edison's company after a few months.

Tesla formed his own electric company in 1885. It wasn't so easy to just get started. when Tesla quit Edison's company, he had to earn money to live on by digging ditches for two dollars a day.

"My high education in various branches of science, mechanics and literature seemed to me





like a mockery." He said of this time. While he was doing that, he was pitching investors by 1885, he was working on getting his arc lighting system patented and had a funding promise to start Tesla Electric Light and Manufacturing. Only a year into the venture, through, they pulled out and left Tesla in the lurch. Yet again, the inventor was penniless In 1886 he met two men who were looking to invest in scientific inventions. They set Tesla up with a laboratory in New York city established a profit sharing structure and the Tesla Electric company was born. In only one year, Tesla had created an induction motor that ran on alternative current. This time he had two business partners who were ready and willing to handle the marketing and business. Tesla patented the motor and showed it off the following year at the American institute of Electrical Engineers that caught the attention of George Westinghouse, a major player in the electric market who realized Tesla's AC motor might just be what he needed to complete his alternative current system and complete against Edison's DC system, Westinghouse licensed Tesla's induction motor and also gave him a consulting job at the Westinghouse Electric and manufacturing lab in Pittsburgh. Westinghouse wanted to be the person who provided the Us with long distance power, and he believed Tesla was the person to help him achieve his goal. In the early 1890s, Westinghouse and Edison were competing heavily in the electric industry. Edison was throwing out claims that Tesla's AC current wasn't safe but Westinghouse paid Tesla for the licensing.



One of Tesla's projects was the Tesla coil, which he patented in 1891, allowed electricity to be transmitted wirelessly. It was the first invention of its kind, and it was used in antennas, used to send telegraphs and even though the original design isn't used anymore a different version of it is still used in TV and radios to this day. Tesla continued his relationship with Westinghouse into the 1890s, as they sought out his help for the 1893 Columbian exposition in Chicago. Here Westinghouse gave demonstrations to the public, showing how an AC current worked. It was clear to the 27 million people who attended that AC would power the future. Their success continued when they out Edison's General Electric again to build the world's first alternating current power plant in Niagara falls. The hydroelectric plant was a massive success. His statue can be found at Niagara falls today. Westinghouse and

Tesla won the war of currents and direct current was being phased out.

Tesla never stopped inventing. Wireless transmission of electricity was one of his main goals, but he needed funding to achieve it. Living in New York, he had ample access to wealthy people. He was able to convince J. Pierpont Morgan of the viability of wireless transmission. He was competing with Marconi to transmit wireless messages, but Marconi got there first investors including Morgan pulled funds from Tesla's project and he was forced to abandon the efforts. This radio incident negatively impacted rest of Tesla's career.

Tesla's mental health deteriorated .He lived his last decade in New Yorker hotel beginning in 1933. Westing house Corporation hired him as a consultant and paid for his room. He lived rent free but died in debt. Behind him, Tesla left a legacy of invention, innovation and scientific exploration. He played a crucial role in the spread of electricity and the creation of devices that led to the technology we have today.

Oprah Winfrey is considered the most influential African American of her generation. She is a role model to many individuals because of her tough childhood, wonderful charity work, her schools and true relationships with her fans. Oprah stands out among many people on her ability to feel others' pain and help those people get through their troubling times.

Oprah Gail Winfrey was born on January 29, 1954. Oprah is an American talk show host, television producer, actress, author and philanthropist. She is best known for her talk show, 'The Oprah Winfrey Show', broadcast from Chicago, which ran in national syndication for 25 years from 1986 to 2011. She was the richest African – American of the 20th century, was once the world's only black billionaire, and the greatest black philanthropist in U.S history.

Much of her turbulent youth was spent in poverty. Her grandmother took care of her till the age of 6. Her grandmother taught her to read before the age of 3. She often wore potato sacks as dresses. She has stated that she was molested during her childhood. She grew up under the shadow of abuse, poverty and neglect, was looked down by many people because of her skin colour, faced severe racism but never not even for a second doubted herself. Winfrey was then sent to live with the man she calls her father, Vernon Winfrey, a barber in Nashville, Tennessee and landed a job in the radio while still in High school. By 19, she was a co-anchor for the local evening news. Winfrey's often emotional, extemporaneous delivery eventually led to her transfer to the daytime talk show arena, and after boosting a third rated local Chicago talk show to first place, she launched her own production company.

By mid 1990's, Winfrey had reinvented her show with a focus on literature, self-improvement, mindfulness and spirituality. Though she has been criticized for unleashing a confession culture, she has also been praised for overcoming adversity to become a benefactor to others. She discussed health, spirituality, literature and social issues in addition to the celebrity interviews for which she had become famous and boasted a worldwide audience for over 100 million. Her talk show called 'the Oprah effect' which influenced the American public in terms of books sales, religion, spirituality, and even political opinions. She also donates more of her money to charity than anyone else in show business.

In 2013, Winfrey was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom by President Barrack Obama and received honorary doctorate degrees from Duke and Harvard. In 2006, she formed her own network (OWN) Oprah Winfrey Network. Winfrey revolutionized the tabloid talk show genre pioneered by Phil Donahue. In 1994, she was inducted to National Women's Hall of Fame. Winfrey has won many accolades throughout her career which includes 18 Daytime Emmy Awards. Bob Hope Humanitarian Award, Tony Award, etc.. Winfrey was also elected as the member of American Academy of arts and sciences in 2021.

ऐल्बर्ट आइंस्टइन

ऐल्बर्ट आइंस्टइन का जन्म १४ मारच १८७९ को जेरमनी में हुआ था। उनके पिता का नाम हरमन आइंस्तइन और माता का नाम पोलिन आइंस्टइन था। जब वह पैदा हुए थे, उनके अंदर एक ऐसी आनोखी बात थी, जो उनको और किसी सामान्य बच्चे को अलग बनाती थी। जैसे वह बडे होने लगे, उनका बोलने में परेशानी होने लगी। इसलिए वह चार साल तक बोल नहीं पाए। बचपन में उनका अपने उम्र के बच्चों के साथ खेलना बिलकुल पसंद नहीं था। उनके मन में यह सवाल हमेशा रहता था कि यह दुनिया कैसे काम करती है। जब वहे ५ साल के थे, उनकेपिता ने उनको एक प्रश्न दिया। उनको यह समझ नहीं आया कि वह हमशा उत्तर कि तरफ रहती है। समय के साथ-साथ वह समझदार बनते गए। उन्होने बहुत खोज किए ऐसे $E = mc^2/1921$ में उनको नोबेल पुरस्कार से सममानित किया गया। 1952 में अमेरिका ने उनको इस्ताएल का राष्ट्रपति बनने की पेशकश दी। उन्होने यह कहकर मना कर दिया कि मैं राष्ट्रपति बनने के लिए नही जन्मा हूँ। उनका जन्मदिन "Genius Day" के नाम पर मनाया जाता है। 1955 में उन्होने अपनी आखरी साँस ली।


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












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
